CORRECTIONS, ADDITIONS, AMENDMENTS TO ISU COMMUNICATION 1610, 1621

I. Corrections to Communication 1610

1. **Page 6**, Combination Spin, Level 2, 12th line should read:
(each difficult variation for at least **3** rotations in a fully established position)
This was a typographical error.

2. **Page 6**, Level 3, Combination Spin, 11th line should read:
(2 for 1 partner and 1 for the other partner or 3 difficult variations in at least **3** different types of basic positions for one partner)
This was a typographical error.

3. **Pages 17 and 18**, Step Sequences, Level 1, 3rd paragraph should begin as follows:
~~Up to two(2) Extra features for each...~~
There is no reason to limit the number of extra features for Level 1.

4. **Page 2**, Note, starting with 5th line from the bottom:
No part of the costume may be used as any support in a Lift. If it happens, ~~the deduction of 1.0 will be applied by the Technical Panel, and the Lift will block a box, but will not count for a value. the couple is to be considered as using a prop, which is not permitted according to Rule 612, and the Referee and Judges will apply the costume deduction of 1.0. The Technical Panel will give the Level according to the Calling Specifications for Lift and will not apply a reduction for the costume.~~
The Congress has decided to place the application of the deduction for costume violations under the responsibility of the Referee and the Judges, and not of the Technical Panel.

Page 9, Calling Specifications for Lifts, delete the last 2 sentences:
~~No part of the costume may be used as any support in a Lift. If it happens, the deduction of 1.0 will be applied by the Technical Panel, and the Lift will block a box, but will not count for a value.~~
Same reason as above.

5. **Page 3**, Step Sequences, change:
If an illegal element is included in either step sequence (e.g. Jump of more than 1 rotation, lying on the ice etc.) the Technical Panel will call the "illegal element" and the entire Step Sequence **Level 1**.
To comply with Rule 611 para a) iv which was passed at the Congress.

Page 16, Note 7, same change as above.

II. Corrections to Communication 1621

1. **Page 8**, Short Dance, d) Pattern, Line 3:
The pattern of the Creative Part must proceed in a generally constant direction (~~either clockwise or anti-clockwise~~).
For this season, this is in conflict with the Short Dance Rule 609 which states that the entire pattern must proceed in a generally constant direction. Since both Pattern Dances that are included in the Short Dance for this season are anti-clockwise, then the Creative Part must also be generally anti-clockwise.

2. **Page 9**: Senior Key Points, Section 2, Key Point I:
RFIRk should be deleted.
The Rocker is not included as a feature for this Key Point.
